I couldn't see how such a little amount could make a difference to anyone, but I suppose that is the difference between want and need. Hunger isn't the only problem here. The elderly, widowed, and orphaned also suffer along with people wasting away from HIV/AIDS. Pray for our ministry among the Samburu people." Southern Baptists like Penny have been ministering to AIDS victims in Africa since the 1980's, thanks to support from churches like yours working together through the Cooperative Program. The people of Kenya need our continued support and prayers.

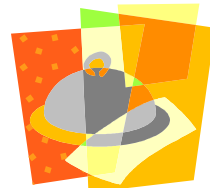

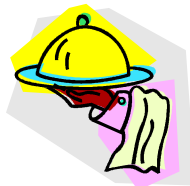


### KEENAGERS
